



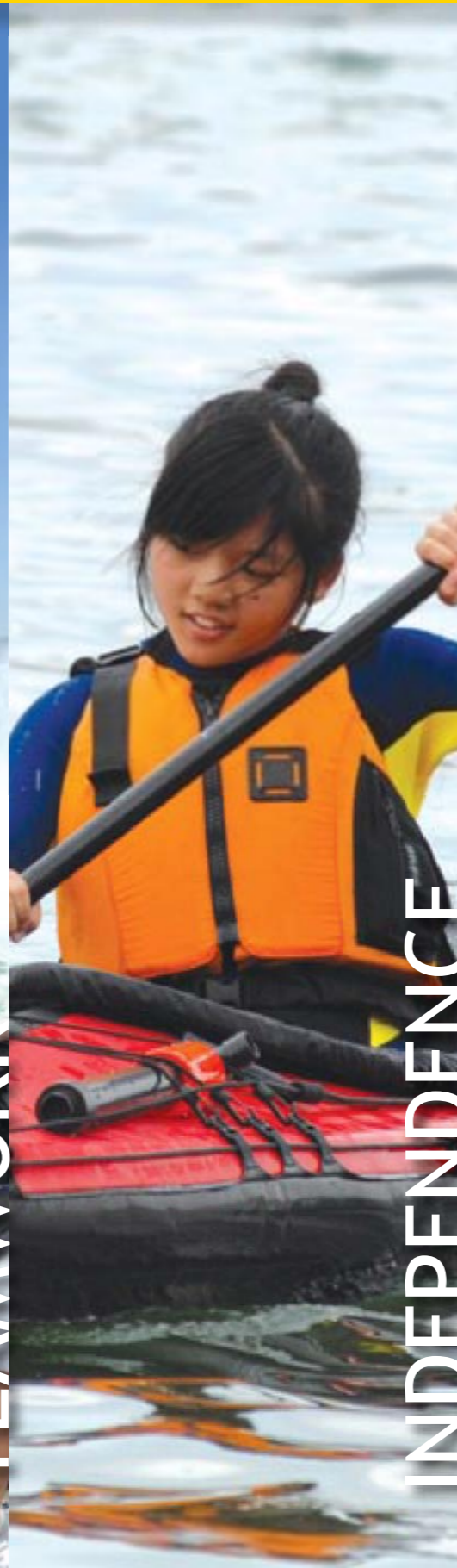

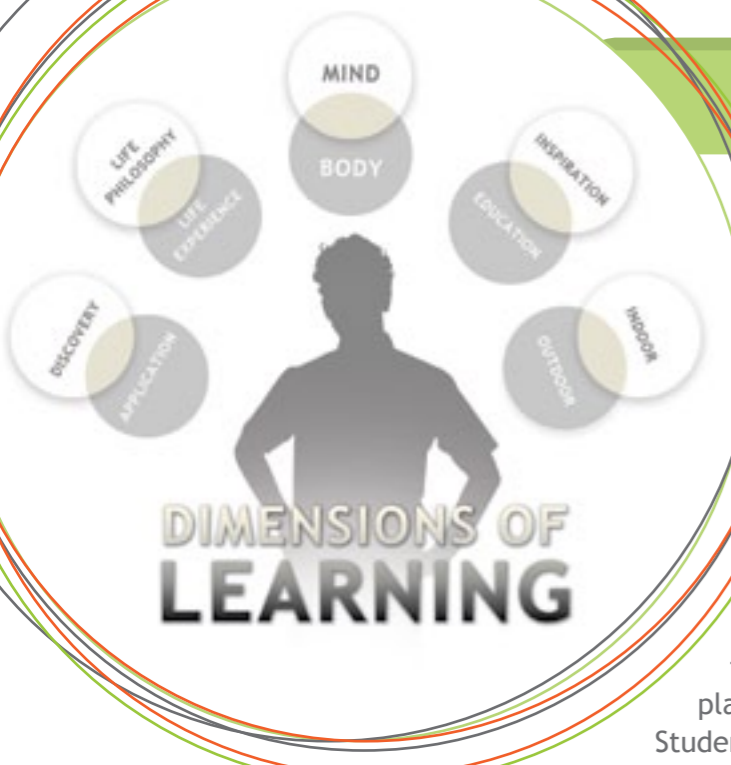
Your Child's First Step to Success
